Question

7. You have an IV solution which is labeled 0.9% sodium chloride and the volume of the IV is 1 L.

How many grams of sodium chloride are in the IV?

Solution

We could make a proportion: 0.9%/100% = x/1L, and we get x = 0.009 mL of NaCl which is approximately equal to 0.009 g of NaCl in 1L of solution.

Answer: 0.009 g.
